no individual grants next to Priority 1



- Payments to Horizon 2020, Euratom, ITER
- Accompanying Measures
 (Information/Advice, Experts, Evaluation)
- Support for Project Submissions (CHF 8'000.-):
 SMEs and Coordinators
- Horizon 2020-Substitutions in Initiatives, Programmes and Projects: COST, Art 185/187 TFEU: AAL, Eurostars, IMI, ...
- Direct Project Funding of H2020 projects (as EC, including Coordination Costs)



Status quo Funding from Berne (SERI) – WHO?

- Institutions: Universities, Universities of Applied Sciences, Academic Institutions, Non- Academic Non-Commercial Research Institutions, further Non-Commercial Institutions
- Firms registered in Switzerland
- (Not: Individual Persons)
- (Variably: Federal Offices...)



Status quo Funding from Berne (SERI) – HOW?

- submit your H2020 project to the EC
- get in touch with Euresearch (<u>www.euresearch.ch</u>), the latest after positive evaluation
- prepare and sign Grant Agreement (GA) with EU
- go to SERI website www.h2020.ch
- follow the instructions (fill in / send form)
- preliminairy check, adaptions and OK by Euresearch
- submit the form to SERI
- SERI funding contract is edited, countersigned
 - -> direct funding from Bern (CHF / xchange rate deadline)
